1. St. Matthew Security Policy and Procedures:

Entering St. Matthew Building – St. Matthew Church and School will be locked during school hours. To enter the building, please come to the main entrance.

1. Please press the intercom/buzzer.
2. Someone will ask you, "Hi, how can I help you?"
3. You will answer, "I am here for International Classes."
4. The door will be unlocked for you.
5. Please go to the Welcome Center, show your photo ID and sign your name, time, and check "International Class" on the folder. You will receive a "visitor" sticker.
6. The person at the Welcome Center will ask for your name and they will check it on a class list.
7. Please proceed to your class or child care location.
8. After class or child care, please sign out the time you leave.

You will need to sign in and sign out like this **every time** you enter and exit the main building. Thank you for your understanding in making this a safe place for everyone. We appreciate your cooperation.

2. If you are going to be absent from class:

These attendance policies are important because of our large waiting lists for many classes. Thank you for your help with the following:

- If you will be absent for any reason – tell your class leader (email, phone call, or text is ok)
- If you are going to be absent for more than 2 weeks at one time (vacation, morning sickness, etc) – tell your class leader (email, phone call, or text is ok).
- If you are very sick or need help in an emergency, please tell us how we may help you or pray for you. We think of you as our friend and we will be concerned if we do not see you.
- If you can no longer take a class please tell your class leader or the International Friends office (email, phone call, or text is ok.)

3. How will I know if class is canceled?

If bad weather or loss of electricity causes school to close for St. Matthew Lutheran School in Walled Lake **OR** Walled Lake Public Schools, then International Friends classes will also close that day. These closings will be announced on TV, WXYZ Channel 7 or Channel 4, or on the radio by WWJ 950AM. You can also check for school closings in Oakland County on this website: www.WXYZ.com. We will notify you by e-mail or phone regarding other important information.

4. Can I bring a friend?

You are welcome to bring a friend to visit your class, and you are welcome to visit other classes one time, then you must register to take the class. Because our childcare is full for all classes, please talk with Becky, Jan or Nora in the International Friend office about availability. Please contact the International Friends office if you wish to visit a class.

5. Photos:

We will be taking pictures this year in our classes and on our field trips. We want to show the fun we have with our friends. These pictures could be used on TV monitor outside the International Friends office and possibly on the St. Matthew web site. Please let us know in the International Office if you would not like your picture used in either of these places. Thank you!

6. Learning About Christianity:

We have resources in many languages about Christianity that you are welcome to borrow. If you need materials in another language, please let us know, and we will get you what you need. On Thursdays, Becky will be leading an easy English discussion group about Jesus, the Bible and other topics that you may be interested in. Everyone is welcome to attend at any time, just contact Becky or our office. You do not have to be Christian to attend.

7. Parking lot safety:

Please follow these rules when you are in the parking lot – this is for your child's safety. Always hold your child's hand when walking to your car in the parking lot. **Never let your children run in the parking lot.**

The traffic is very heavy in the entire parking lot at 3:30-3:45 pm when St. Matthew School ends. Over 100 cars exit the parking lot together! Please take special care to keep your children close to you if you leave the building at that time.

8. Lobby Etiquette:

There will be a staff person working in the lobby "Welcome Center" to welcome and assist you. We ask that you respect their work environment. Please teach your children not to run, jump, or yell. Please do not leave your children unattended in the lobby. If you would like to continue talking with your friends after class time, please pick up your children from child care and return to your classroom.

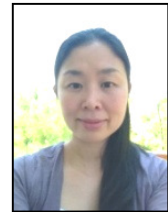
